

# iDOGI announces the installation of 'Meridies' A unique chandelier at Raffles London at The OWO



iDOGI is proud to announce that a majestic chandelier, crafted over the last few years by iDOGI, creators of bespoke oversized artistic lighting, is now suspended from the magnificent dome above the grand marble and alabaster staircase at Raffles London at The OWO.

This dramatic staircase is in the centre of the Whitehall Wing which overlooks the regal Whitehall throughfare, opposite the official entrance to Buckingham Palace. The hotel is set to o pen later this summer for all to admire this glittering addition to the capital.

The chandelier was designed by iDOGI, an Italian company based in Venice, and is made up of an astounding 3085 elements and 96 lights. This breath-taking piece of art took approximately more than one year to complete from concept to shipping. This proves the level of detail, time and effort which went into creating such a magnificent light fixture.

The chandelier consists of two vertically-aligned globes made of the finest hand-blown and hand-crafted Venetian crystal. The two globes represent respectively the British and the Italian culture, united in their quest to create timeless beauty.

The name of this bespoke chandelier is 'Meridies'. This name was chosen to signify the close interweaving of arms (think of the meridians in our body) that are a symbolic reflection of the close-knit links that existed between the British Empire and the Republic of Venice (often referred to as Venice's Serenissima Republic, or the "Most Serene Republics").

Both the British Empire and the Republic of Venice were sovereign maritime nations based on trading. Although the cultures were different, they were both powerful in their reach and influence around the world, and in the beauty of the art and crafts produced and traded.

The iDOGI designers looked at geographical, cartographical, and historical references when researching this fabulous design.

It is designed to be a visual image of a union – in history and today. It intends to celebrate power, connection, and the ultimate strength of the unity of nations, while respecting their diversity. And in diversity, celebrating uniqueness.

To summarise, 'Meridies', a gem by iDOGI, creators of bespoke lighting have united with Raffles London at The OWO, to bring a new light, a new gleam and a new meaning to this grand entrance. To breathe new life into one of Britain's most historic buildings.

Matteo Canepari, Head of Design and Planning at The OWO says: "iDOGI have defied the impossible by creating this majestic works of art to proudly light the way for all guests as they enter Raffles London at The OWO. The age-old tradition of Venetian Glass Masters has been perfected by their craftsmanship and their love for beauty. They combine this tradition with forward-thinking innovation. In this way the chandelier is perfectly placed in our Grade II\* listed Edwardian masterpiece which has been passionately restored for future generations to enjoy."

To understand the sheer size of the chandelier, the measurements are 230cm in diameter and 815cm in height. iDOGI deployed a large team to worked together in order to create this piece of art. There were three people on the creative team designing the light, four people on the technical team and three people on the glass master team. Furthermore, there were five people on the production team, who put together the chandelier's technical structure and applied all the decorative parts. Two team members were appointed for the final check of the light and four team members assisted with packaging the light ready to be shipped to London.

About the Grand Staircase at Raffles London at The OWO: The entrance hall is off Whitehall and when the Old War Office was opened in 1906 it was important for staircases in government buildings to convey the majesty of Empire, with architecture that, figuratively, brought visitors to their knees. The grand staircase is framed by the marble alabaster stairs and magnificent Portland stone columns. It

is two stories high, with a groined ceiling and Portland stone columns and the staircase displays a rich variety of stones: Painswick stone walls, English alabaster balusters, handrail of Brescia marble, paving and steps in Piastraccia Italian marble. Richly veined, they were opulently coloured to sumptuous effect, in shades of amber, aubergine and off-white. Historically at night, the grand staircase was lit by concealed lights behind the cornice and from bronze lanterns hanging in the corridors: the modern wonder of electricity. The entrance area has a black-and-white tile floor and highly decorative ceilings with neo-baroque fibrous plasterwork. It has an arcade and surrounding gallery above it.
